

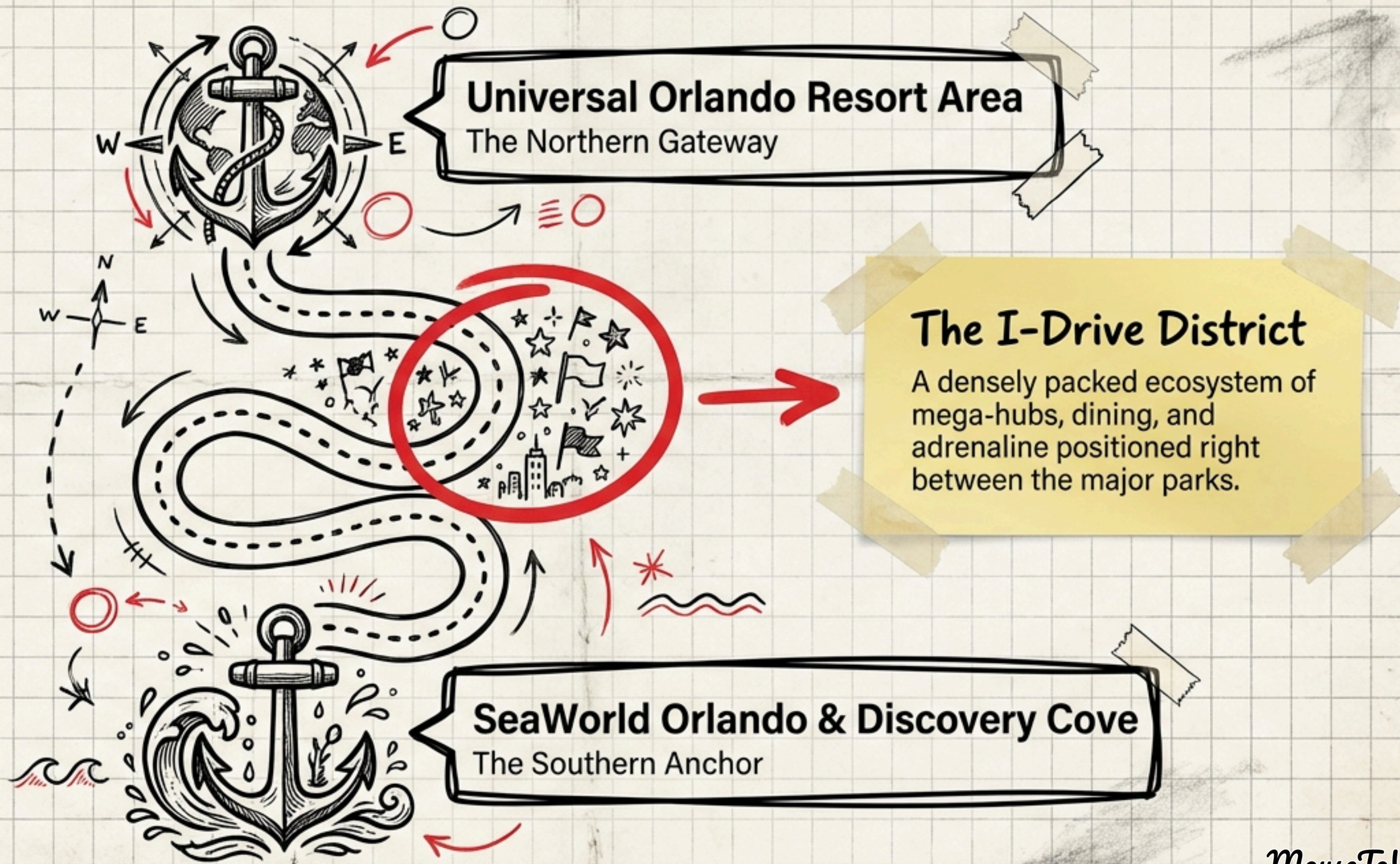

Panel 2: SeaWorld Parks & Resorts

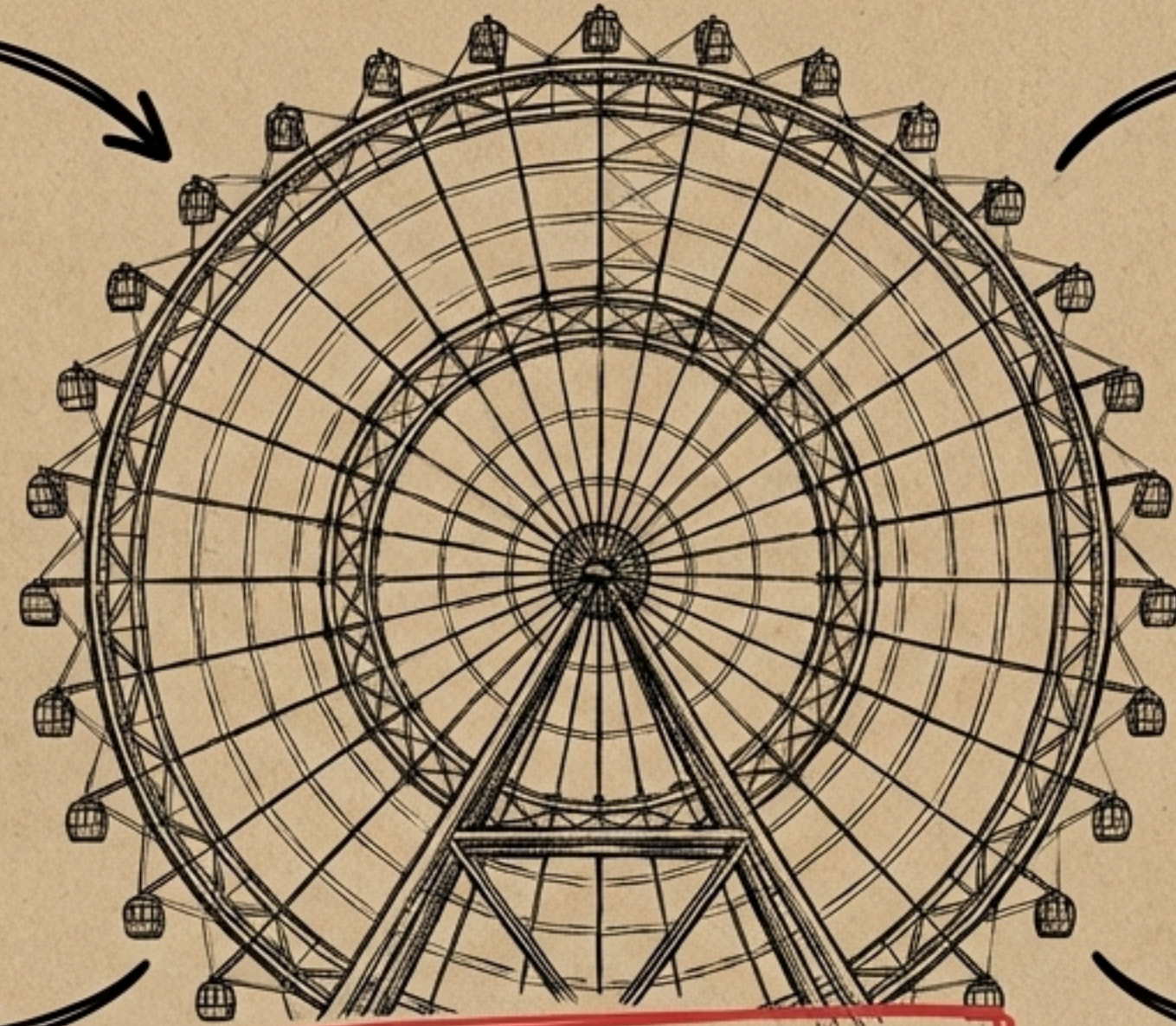
● **Vibe:** Aquatic thrills and up-close animal encounters.

# Mega-Hub 2: Pointe Orlando vs. Dezerland

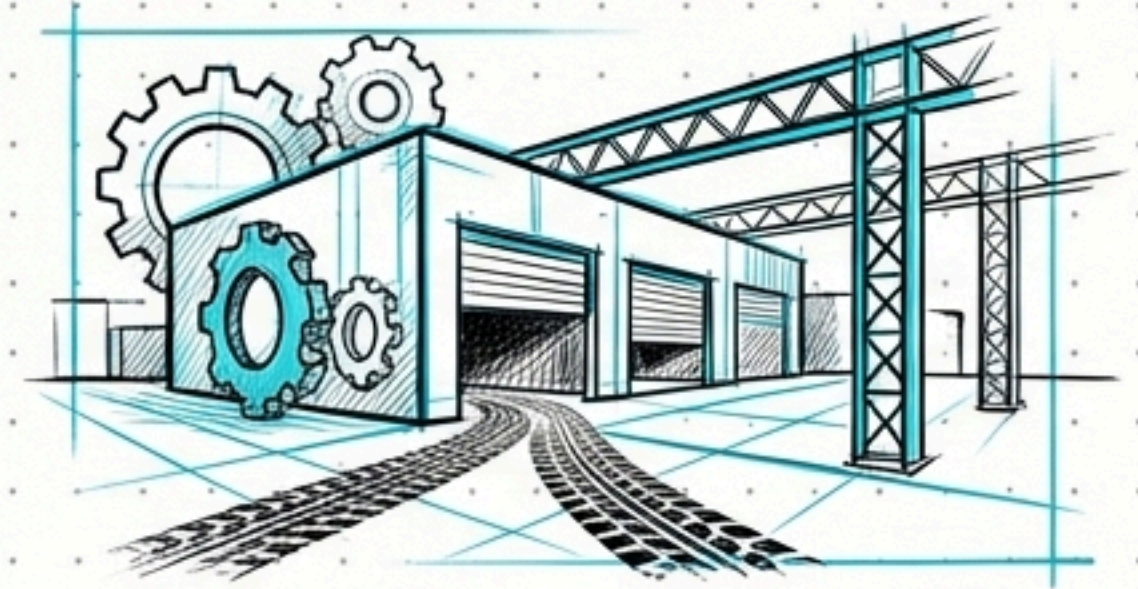


## Left Column (Pointe Orlando)

**Vibe:** Walkable, breezy, and culinary-focused.



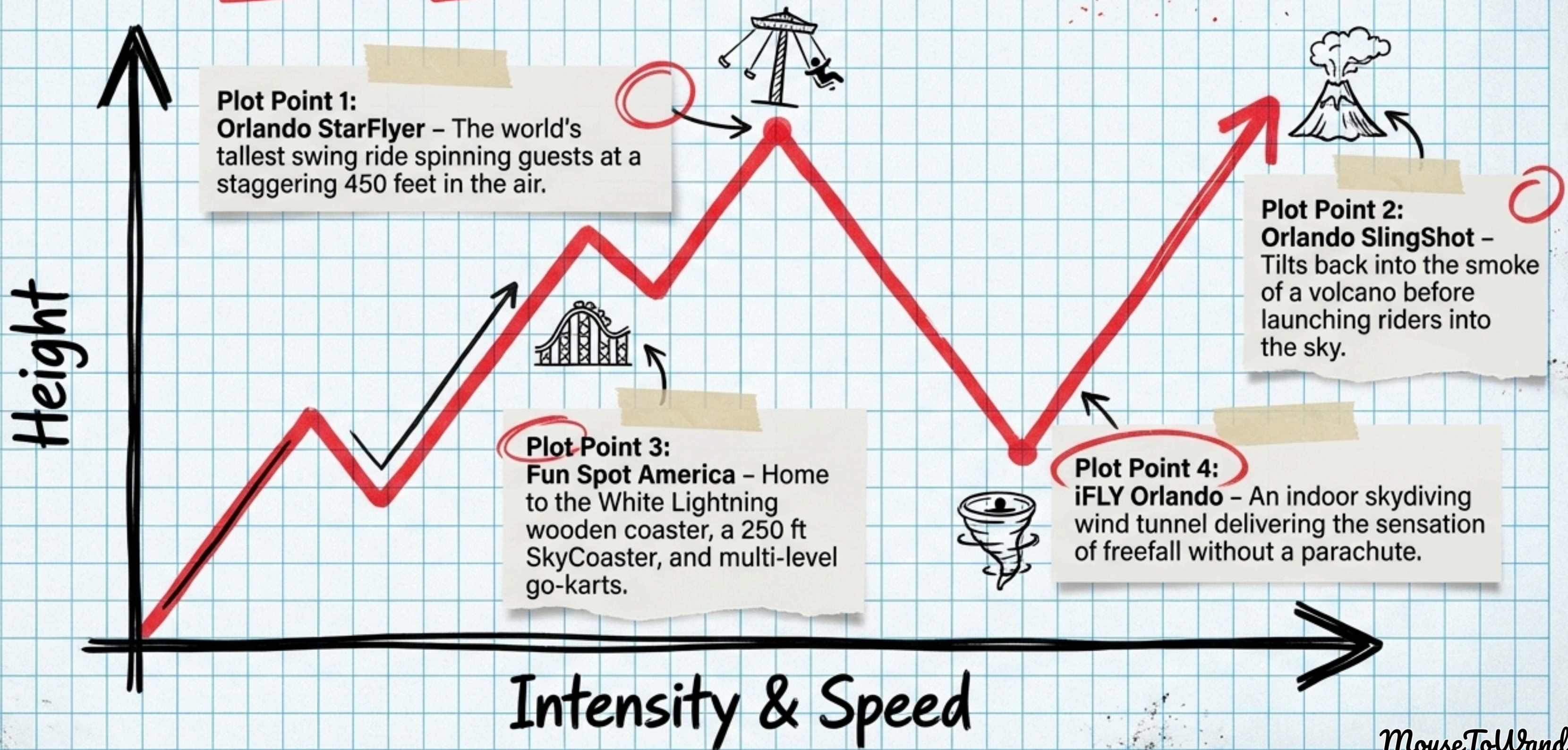
## Right Column (Dezerland Park)

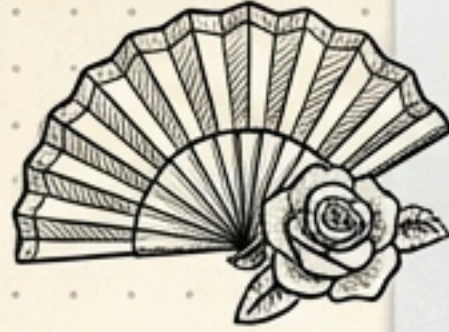

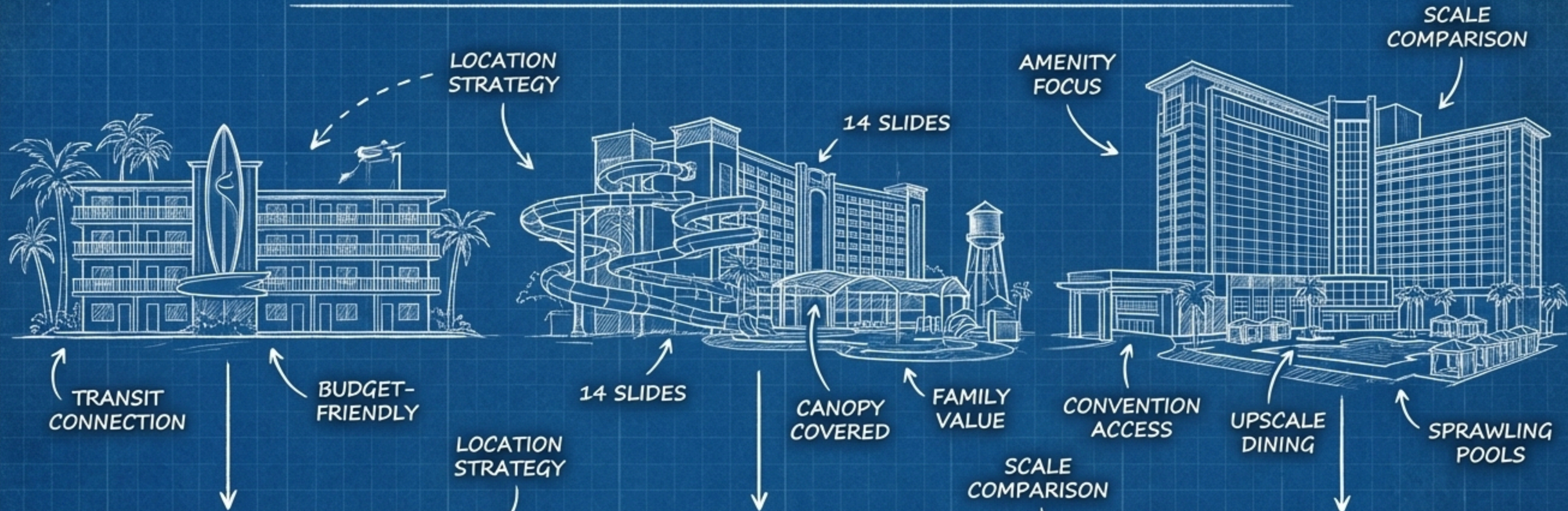

Universal's Endless Summer Resort (Surfside & Dockside). Budget-friendly, immersive, and heavily integrated into the Universal transit system.

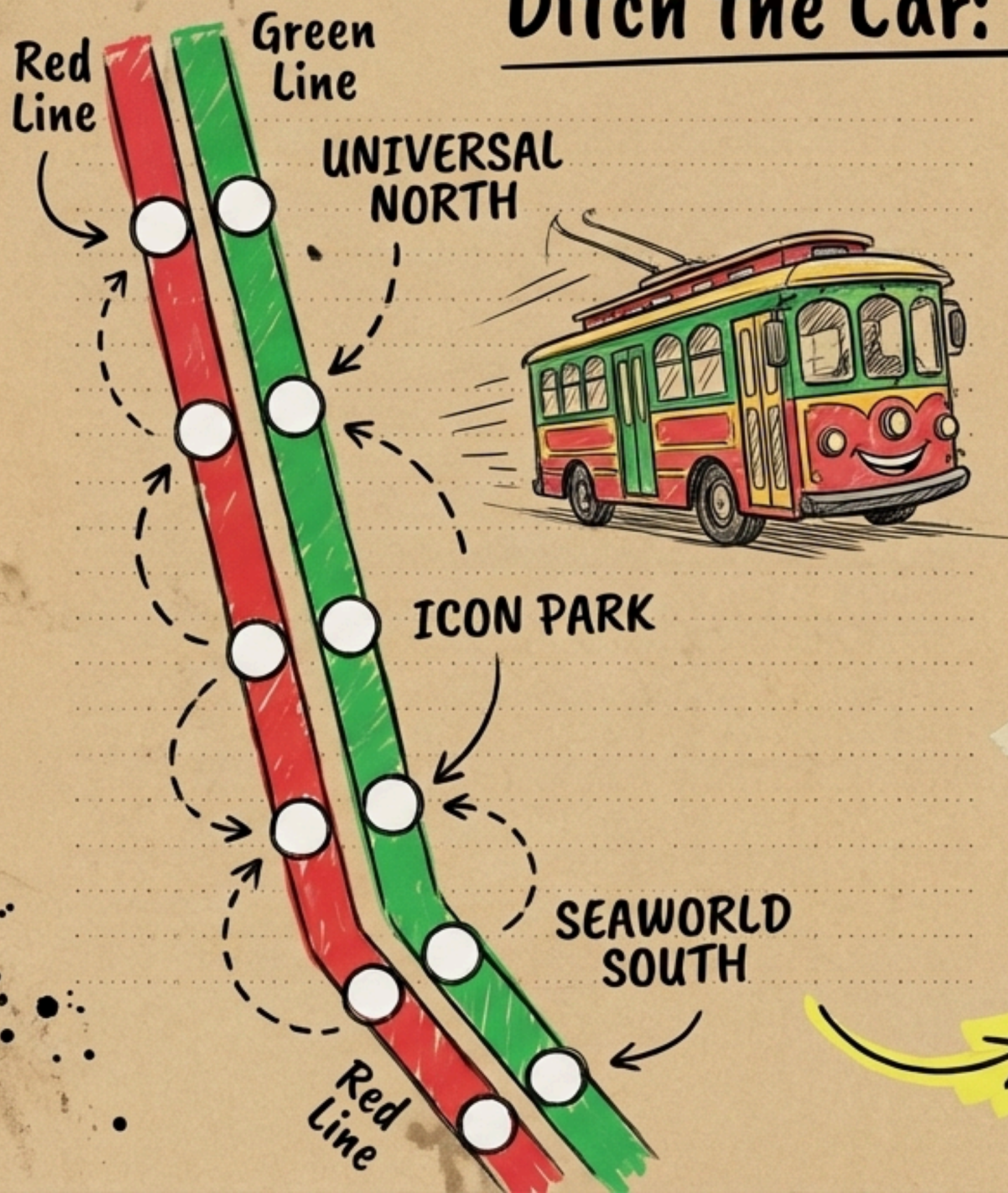
## Profile 2: The Built-In Waterpark

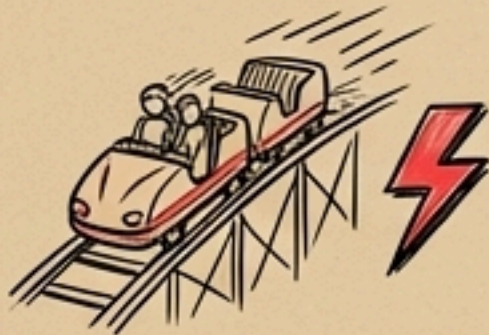
# Synthesis: Two Perfect Days on I-Drive

## Track A: The High-Octane Day

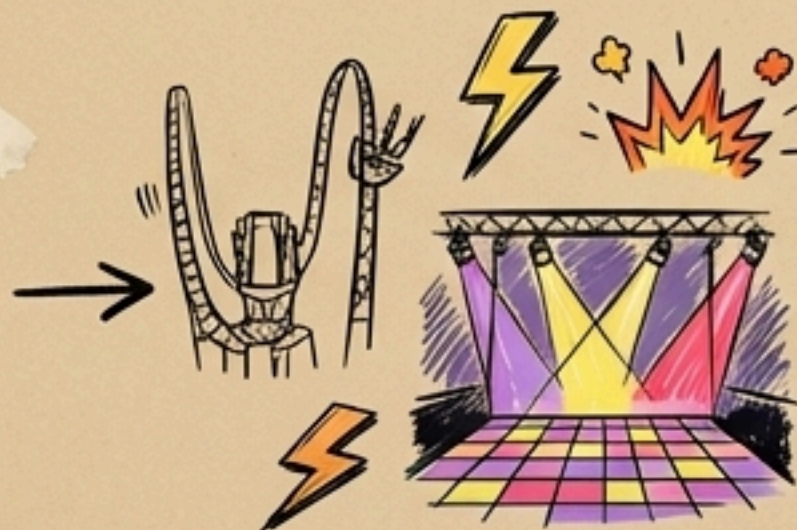
Morning: Fly without a plane in the wind tunnel at iFLY.
